

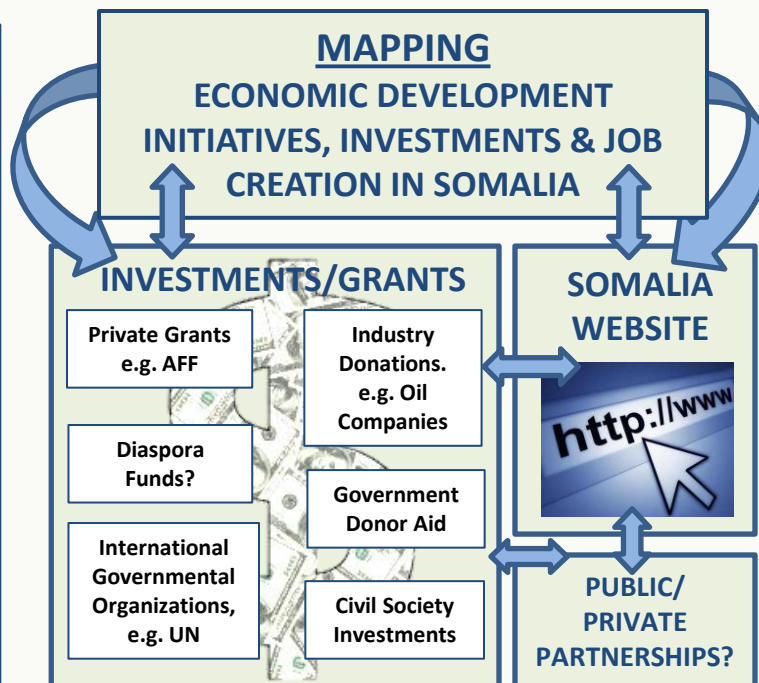


INVESTING IN SOMALIA

About the *Investing in Somalia* Program

In April 2012, OEF launched its *Investing in Somalia* program. This initiative will support and complement the work of OEF's *Oceans Beyond Piracy* program by supporting sustainable, long-term efforts in Somalia which promote sustainable economic development.

Phase One (2012) of the program, will deliver an in-depth mapping of economic development projects in Somalia. This mapping will be compiled on a publicly available website, to be launched in September 2012 (see further details on next page). The research and analysis is intended to be used to identify and draw attention to effective projects for financial grants and investments. It should also encourage alignment and continuity of existing efforts.



OEF's Chairman Commits \$1 million in Donations to Somalia

Philanthropist, and Chairman of One Earth Future Foundation, Marcel Arsenault, announced in June 2012 that he will commit at least \$1 million over two years in financial grants to encourage sustainable economic development in Somalia.

The grants will focus on supporting job creation and alternative livelihood initiatives in Somalia. Grants will provide seed funding to projects which are scalable, replicable, and sustainable.

The commitment builds on Mr. Arsenault's previous grants to NGOs and international organizations working on the ground in Somalia, such as UNODC, Radio Daljir, Somali Fair Fishing, and SAACID. OEF is also delighted to see other industry initiatives supporting Somali economic development, such as the 'Joint Industry Contribution to Support Community Projects in Somalia,' launched in February 2012 by BP, Shell, Maersk, and the Japanese shipping industry, which pledged \$2 million for community projects in Somalia.

OEF is committing substantial staff and resources to build an online platform to track and assess economic development projects in Somalia. The objectives of this research and mapping are to:

- Help international funders identify projects in Somalia for potential funding.
- Showcase best practices in economic development which optimize job creation in Somalia.
- Foster and facilitate international funding into Somalia, especially from the private sector and diaspora.
- Assist in the coordination of multi-stakeholder (business, government, civil society) initiatives and funding in Somalia to promote job creation.
- Initial mapping and research will focus on NGOs and non-profit organizations; future phases will include businesses and entrepreneurial initiatives.
